## Who May Use LXP Services

**Any use or access by anyone under the age of 13 is strictly prohibited.**

## Rules for Online Conduct

You agree that you are responsible for your own use of the LXP Site and for your User Postings. # Honor Code

## Collaboration Policy

By enrolling in a course on LXP, you are joining a community of learners. The aspiration of LXP is to provide our learners with an excellent educational experience. You are a part of the community that will help LXP achieve this goal. LXP depends upon your motivation to learn the material and to do so with honesty and academic integrity. In order to participate in LXP, you must agree to the Honor Code below and any additional terms specific to a course or program. This Honor Code, and any additional terms, will be posted on each course website.

## Honor Code Pledge

By enrolling in an LXP course or program, I agree that I will:

- Complete all activities on my own and submit only my own work, unless collaboration is explicitly permitted.
- Not make solutions to activities available to anyone else (except to the extent an activity explicitly permits sharing solutions).
- Maintain only one user account, unless LXP has approved the use of a separate user account in connection with an employer-sponsored or university-sponsored program.
- Not let anyone else use my username and/or password.
- Not engage in any activity that would dishonestly improve my results, or improve or hurt the results of others.
- Not post answers to problems that are being used to assess learner performance.

## Violations

If you are found in violation of the Terms of Service or Honor Code, you may be subject to one or more of the following actions:

- Receiving a zero or no credit for an assignment;
- Having any certificate earned in the course or program withheld or revoked;
- Being unenrolled from a course or program; or
- Termination of your use of the LXP Site and Services.

# Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice (“Notice”) explains the data privacy practices of the Learner Experience Platform (“LXP”) in connection with your use of the LXP Site and other LXP Services. The LXP Services are defined in our [Terms of Service](#). Capitalized terms contained but not otherwise defined in this Notice have the meanings provided in our Terms of Service.

Although LXP is a platform operated by Harvard University, this Notice does not apply to information that you may provide to Harvard University or other Harvard University units independently of the LXP Site and Services.

Your use of our Services is subject to the LXP [Terms of Service](#). Additional terms may apply for specific Services. If such terms apply, they will control over any conflicting terms in this Notice to the extent permitted under applicable law.

The information you provide to LXP allows us to provide you with access to the LXP Site, to provide the Services to you, to administer the LXP Site, and to keep you updated on services we provide.

By accessing or using our Services, you agree to our collection and use of information in accordance with this Notice.

## Information We May Collect and From Whom

We collect information, including personal data, when you sign up for a user account, download an application, participate in our online courses or programs, or otherwise communicate with LXP. Personal data is any information that can be used to identify you. Personal data we collect may include:

- **Contact Information** such as full name and email address.
- **Account Information** such as username and password.
- **Educational Information** such as student identification number, courses taken and currently registered for, course progress, and course grade.
- **Online and Electronic Information** such as browser ID, browser type, device ID, device type, operating system, network carrier or data providers, and IP address.
- **Usage Data** such as cookies, content viewed or posted, frequency of visits, other Website browsing information, and preferences.

## Sources of Information

We may receive information directly from you or from third parties such as your educational institution if you are enrolled in our Services through or in connection with an organizational agreement.

## How We May Use Your Information

We may use your personal data:

- To deliver, develop, analyze, support, secure, and improve the LXP Site and Services.
- To send you notices, updates, announcements, communications, and marketing and promotional content (whether by email, phone, pop up notifications, or other similar methods) about the Services or other programs, services, products, events, opportunities or activities offered through the LXP Site, or by a Harvard school or Harvard University, or selected educational or business partners, that may be of interest to you.
- To authenticate your identity.
- To perform research (such as academic research).
- To assess admissions criteria and analyze individual and aggregate progress, performance, and completion of the Services.
- To achieve any purpose to which you have consented at the point of collection of information or at another time.
- To establish, exercise, or defend our legal rights, for example in connection with threatened or pending litigation or claims or to enforce our contractual or other rights.
- To aggregate and/or de-identify your personal data so that the information can no longer be linked to you or your device. We may use the aggregated and/or de-identified information for any purpose, including without limitation for research and marketing purposes, and may also share such data with any third parties, including advertisers, promotional partners, and sponsors.
- To achieve any purpose described elsewhere in this Notice, to respond to inquiries, and in accordance with our legal obligations (including, without limitation, disclosures permitted under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy regulations (collectively, “FERPA”), to the extent FERPA applies to the information).

## Information Sharing

We share your personal data with your consent or as necessary to provide a Service you have requested. For example, we share some of your information with faculty and staff in connection with your program, and other participants in your program can view your profile and your comments in, for example, social and peer learning environments. We also share with a limited number of third-party contractors who perform certain functions on our behalf.

Comments or other information posted or contributed by you to any part of a Service designed to

be visible to the public or to other LXP participants may be viewed and downloaded by others who use or access the Service. Please bear this in mind when you post such comments or other information.

We may, for example, share information under the following circumstances:

- To provide or conduct the Services by sharing submissions, such as posted data referenced above, with other participants in an LXP program or other Services in which you are participating.
- If the Services you use are subject to FERPA, we may disclose information consistent with FERPA to the extent FERPA applies.
- To share information with a collaborating educational institution with which you are associated, regarding participation in the Services.
- To share information provided by you or collected about you via the Services within Harvard University to provide the Services.
- To report to your company, organization or educational institution on your progress and participation in a Service if your participation in the Service is sponsored by your company, organization or educational institution, and if you have so consented or we are otherwise permitted to do so.
- To enable LXP, either directly or through third parties, to conduct marketing and advertising activities (such as interest-based advertising).
- To share aggregated, anonymized, or de-identified information with the public and with third parties, including but not limited to researchers and business partners.

## Cookies

Some personal information may be collected through cookies, pixel tags, scripts, log files, web beacons and other similar technologies. We may use cookies and similar technologies to:

- Collect information about participant experience.
- Track information about a user's interactions with a website or Service, including, among other things, which portions or pages of a website or Service were visited, the order in

which they were visited, when they were visited, the user's mouse movements, and which hyperlinks and other user interface controls were used.

- Determine your (or your device or ISP's) non-specific geographic location.
- Collect information regarding your IP address, unique IDs of cookies, unique IDs sent from mobile devices, and other device and electronic information.
- Serve content or advertisements that match your preferred interests.

## What are cookies, pixel tags, scripts, log files, web beacons and similar technologies?

These are technologies that record information or perform specific functions when you access or use our Services. The data collected or generated by these technologies helps us perform a variety of functions such as operating the Services, measuring and improving the performance of the Services, understanding your preferences, and delivering content to you. The data files may be placed directly onto your computer or device by your web browser or they might be embedded in a webpage or email that you access.

Pixel tags (also called web beacons or clear GIFs) are typically invisible tags placed on certain pages of the Services but not on your computer or device. When you access those pages, pixel tags generate a generic notice of your visit. Pixel tags usually work in conjunction with cookies, registering when a particular computer or device visits a particular page. This can help us personalize the presentation of the Services for you. If you turn off cookies, the pixel tag will simply detect an anonymous visit.

Our websites use the following categories of cookies:

LXP has a program designed to protect personal data in its possession or control. Nonetheless, no method of collection, storage or transmission is entirely secure, and we cannot guarantee that our security measures will be effective. The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of the LXP Site or Services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. Do not share your password with anyone.

### Retention of Your Information

The length of time for which we retain information depends on the purposes for which we collected and used it, requirements of applicable laws, the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of the information, the resolution of any pending or threatened disputes, and enforcement of our agreements.

### Collection of Data from Children

Our Services are generally not intended for users under the age of 18. From time to time, we may offer certain Services to users under 18 years of age (but 13 years of age or older). In those cases, we may have additional requirements for registration or access to our Services, including, for example, approval of a parent or other authorized person. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children under 13. For example, we will retain information about your course performance and information we require for regulatory compliance, among other things.

### Changing our Privacy Notice

We may make changes to this Notice at any time. By registering for, accessing or using the LXP Site or any of the Services after any changes have been made, you signify your agreement to the modified Notice and all of the changes, which will be effective immediately unless we notify you of a later effective date. If the changes are not acceptable to you, you should discontinue use of the LXP Site and/or Services.
